Elementary Mass Choir:

The Middle Tennessee Vocal Association (MTVA) Elementary Mass Choir is a one-day event for students in grades 4-6. We are fortunate to have two fabulous clinicians this year and we are hoping for NO SNOW! For this event, there is no individual audition to participate. Each school’s music teacher must be a member of MTVA and NAFME to participate. There are two sessions to choose from for the day:

Morning Session 9:30-12:30 rehearsal with Mrs. Beth Kolwyck

Afternoon Session 1:30-4:30 rehearsal with Mrs. Amy Swanson

The concert is at 6:30pm for both groups. The music teacher registers their elementary choir for this event online and purchases the music for the chosen session. Students arrive for their session and work with the clinician for three hours. Then, students come back for the concert that evening. Students that attend the morning session leave and come back, while students that attend the afternoon session eat dinner (either off-site or on-site) and then change and prepare for the concert. Students should have all music memorized before the date of the event. Directors are expected to remain on site and assist with all rehearsals, breaks, lunch/dinner, and the performance. Concert attire will be white shirt and black pants/skirts along with black shoes. Girls that choose to wear skirts must wear black hose with their skirt. This event is limited to 300-310 students per session due to size of the performance venue.
